"Bokebo" or Älmeberg 106 near Torup is a holiday home from 1964 with approx. 70 m² of living space + approx. 9 m² covered south-facing terrace. The house has been continuously renovated and extended over the years and is in good condition, ready for use. Good metal roof, newer insulated windows throughout, updated and partially replaced electrical installations, and both kitchen and bathroom from around 2007. Deep-drilled well, 214 m, from 2007 and an approved three-chamber septic system with infiltration from 2008 (inspected 2025).
